

LOKAHI DANCE 2021-2022 DANCE SEASON POLICIES & CLASS INFORMATION

TUITION

Season Classes

- 2021-2022 Season Classes run <u>August 23rd May 29</u>. Tuition for the Season can be paid in full or will be divided into 9 equal monthly installments.
- First month's payment is due upon enrollment and covers the billing session August 23rd September 30th.
- First month's payment is prorated upon enrollment.
- Tuition payments are the same every month regardless of holidays, inclement weather, or statewide closures.
- Billing is set up to withdraw automatic monthly payments from the credit card or debit card attached to your
 account. Tuition will be withdrawn on the <u>1st day of each month through May</u>.
- A late fee of \$15 will apply to unpaid tuition balances on the 5th of the month. Please keep your account information up to date to avoid late fees!
- A Registration Fee of \$25 will apply to each Family upon enrollment.

45min. class per week - \$55 monthly installment 60min. class per week - \$62 monthly installment

Recreational Classes

- Tuition for Recreational Classes must be paid in full and due upon enrollment. Please see the recreational class schedule for pricing and dates.
- No registration fee for Recreational Classes.
- · Recreational Classes do not participate in Recital

- Recital Fee \$95 per student is due by November 1st, 2021
- Includes: 2 Tickets, 1 Costume, Digital Show Recording, and Award for Completing the Season
- Additional tickets will be available for purchase in the Spring
- · Recital Fees are Non-Refundable
- Participation is strongly encouraged for Season Class Students. Participation is mandatory for Season Acro Students.

CLOSURES / CANCELLATIONS

- The studio will be closed on the holidays listed below. There are no refunds or credits for these closures. Season
 Tuition is based on a 36-week Season equating to an average of 4 classes per month.
- We reserve the right to cancel class due to inclement weather or mandatory evacuations. If classes are cancelled, you will be notified by email. No refunds or credits will be issued.

- If mandatory statewide or county closures occur, Lokahi Dance may transition in-person classes to virtual classes and tuition will be due as usual. No refunds or credits will be issued.
- We reserve the right to cancel class due to low enrollment. A minimum of 5 students are required to hold a class.
- In the event a teacher is sick, a substitute teacher will be provided OR a make-up class will be scheduled.
- Make-up classes due to student illness can be taken in any class of the same age/level within the same month of missed class. Please contact us to schedule your make-up class.
- No refunds or credits will be issued for missed classes.
- We require a 2-week written withdrawal notice to to cancel your enrollment. Please let us know by emailing us 2-weeks prior to the next billing cycle to avoid tuition charges. All fees are non-refundable.
- If we are unable to process your tuition and there is no contact for 15 days, your enrollment will be dropped.
 Registration fees will apply upon re-enrollment.

CLASS INFORMATION AND ETIQUETTE

- Please arrive between 5-10 minutes prior to class time.
- We prefer students to be dropped off (ages 4+) to eliminate distractions in the studio. A parent may stay in the lobby as long as they observe QUIETLY. You are responsible for your children before and after class time.
- Students who arrive late to class are asked to wait at the entrance of the dance floor until the teacher signals it's safe to enter class.
- Please have your child use the restroom BEFORE class. We require all of our students to be fully potty trained and independent using the restroom.
- Students must remain in the lobby or student lounge until the instructor begins class. Absolutely NO running or horseplay anywhere in the building.
- · Keep your child home if they have a fever or show signs of illness.
- Please no food or chewing gum in the studio.
- We encourage students to bring a water bottle to class!

DRESS CODE

- Dance shoes only on studio floor. Refrain from wearing dance shoes outside of the studio.
- Please remove hanging jewelry before entering the studio floor.
- · Hair must be styled back away from face.

Hula - Bare Feet, Stretch Shorts or Leggings, Hula Skirt (Pa'u), Tank or T-Shirt

Modern Combo - Black Jazz Shoes, Leggings or Tights, Leotard

Acro - Bare Feet, Leotard, Stretch Shorts or Leggings
